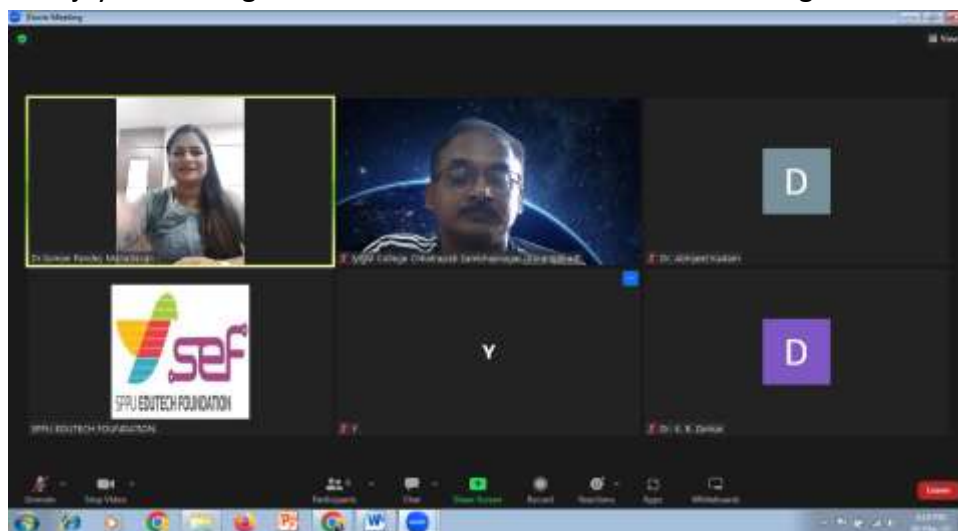


**Marathwada Sanskrutik Mandal's
